

Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. The Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut does not provide any scuba training and does not incur any liability associated with training conducted by a scuba diving center or independent instructor.
2. The recipient agrees to hold harmless, indemnify, and defend the Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut, its directors, officers, employees and agents from and against all claims, liabilities, damages, losses, and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from:
 - Any injury, including bodily injury or death, or any damage to property that occurs in connection with the training;
 - The recipient's use of the grant funds;
 - Any acts or omissions of the recipient in connection with the award or mission of the Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut.
3. If selected for a scholarship, the recipient will be required to complete all required paperwork for your training with the scuba diving center or independent instructor including liability releases and medical questionnaire. If not completed, the scholarship will be revoked.
4. If the recipient is not medically cleared for training as outlined in the Diver Medical Participant Questionnaire, the scholarship will be revoked.
5. If applying for the Ocean Steward I – Open Water Scholarship, the applicant must be a current Connecticut high school student carrying at least a 2.0 GPA and has not yet matriculated.
6. If applying for the Ocean Steward II – Advanced Open Water Scholarship, the applicant are Connecticut resident 21 years of age or younger and already a certified open water diver with any training agency.
7. Applicants may be interviewed by the Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut prior to awarding of scholarships.
8. If selected, training must be completed in the calendar year in which the scholarship is offered. Training not completed in the calendar year will result in forfeiture of any remaining scholarship funds.
9. If selected, the recipient agrees that the Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut can use your name and photograph(s) to support the mission of the organization.
10. Scholarship funds may be paid directly to the scholarship recipient, scuba diving center or independent instructor as follows

For Ocean Steward I – Open Water Scholarship

- \$250 upon completion of electronic learning
- \$250 upon completion of confined water training
- \$200 upon completion of open water certification dives

For Ocean Steward II – Advanced Open Water Scholarship

- \$200 upon completion of electronic learning
- \$500 upon completion of advanced open water dives

This payment plan may be modified by Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut.

11. The Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut reserves the right to suspend the scholarship program at any time. Submission of an application does not guarantee that a scholarship will be awarded.
12. The Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut may revise the schedule for application and award at any time.
13. The Scuba Educational Alliance of Connecticut reserves the right to modify these terms and conditions at any time.
14. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Connecticut.
